The Lone Butte Fire Dept is currently looking for volunteers to assist with its operations in the following capacities:

Firefighters; firefighters respond to emergencies in the community to help manage the incident and resolve it safely and efficiently, these incidents include fires, motor vehicle accidents, spills etc. Most of the Lone Butte firefighters are also EMA-First Responders. First Responders are trained in pre hospital patient care and attend certain types of medical emergencies in our community and assist the B.C. Ambulance Service with patient care.

Auxiliary Fire Fighters; auxiliary fire fighters may have previous firefighting experience but are not able to commit to the regular training and call-outs. They are called upon for larger incidents to assist in fire-ground operations or to staff the fire hall depending on their experience.

Associate Members; associate members need no firefighting experience. They may assist in operations as dispatchers or provide support to incidents, but mainly assist the department in the day to day operations of the hall; equipment and apparatus inspections, health and safety, fire prevention, etc. They attend general meetings and assist the department in meeting our short and long-term goals.
